



Expert Diaa Rashwan from Al⁻Ahram Center for Political and Strategic Studies expressed that the transfer of authority in the Muslim Brotherhood Movement that was recently witnessed was truly an example for all to learn. He stressed that the Movement truly demonstrated that the key to successful leadership today is through influence, not authority where setting an example is not the main means of influencing another, it is the only means.
