Also, we call for formation of special popular groupings to support Palestine, and activation of civil society organizations, including: political parties, associations, groups, syndicates, and unions, to provide media, political and financial support.

We also urge the Muslim peoples around the world to ensure that the Palestinian cause will be always present on

their agenda. We still have a lot to do, and we definitely can do a lot – until Allah lifts the affliction, the occupation ends, and the blessed Al-Aqsa Mosque is liberated.
