

MB: We Appreciate Hamas's Political Resilience in Support of Its Popular Incubator



The Muslim Brotherhood (MB) appreciates the Islamic Resistance Movement Hamas's positive response to the Egyptian-Qatari proposal regarding the ceasefire negotiations and prisoner swap, and views it as a positive political action to the movement leadership's credit, in order to achieve the interests of the Gaza Strip and the Palestinian people, and in respect of the political mediators and the agreement guarantors, regardless of the occupying entity's attitude towards the proposal.
