

MB Blesses Sinwar's Selection as the New Hamas Leader



The Muslim Brotherhood (MB) appreciates the selection of Leader Yahya Sinwar as the new head of the Islamic Resistance Movement Hamas's political bureau, succeeding Martyr Ismail Haniyeh.
