

## MB: We Condemn the Assassination Crime Against Mujahid Scholar Hussein Atwi And Extend Our Condolences



In the name of Allah, most gracious, most merciful: {Among the believers are men true to what they promised Allah. The Muslim Brotherhood (MB) condemns the heinous Zionist crime that has targeted the mujahid scholar Sheikh Hussein Izzat Atwi, a leader of the Islamic Group (known as Al-Jama'ah Al-Islamiyah -JI) in Lebanon and a member of the International Union of Muslim Scholars (IUMS).
